When any visitor approaches the clinic, the biggest changes he or she will notice are on the second floor. The walls are coming up, and a ramp has been completed to assure access for those who are mobility challenged. The dental and eye clinics are both in the process of moving to this area, to not only improve the caregiving for both

specialties, but also to provide space on the first floor for future inpatient services. The completion of the project is funding-dependent but we have a good start! We look forward to the day that we can provide even more help for those who are suffering with dental and/or vision problems in Christ's name.

A DAY IN THE LIFE OF THE CLINIC

As the sun rises around 6:00 a.m., the gates to the Hospital Leglise de Dieu Reformee open. The patients are already waiting outside to assure their place in line to be seen. The stream of people continues steadily. One of the morning security guards gives each person a number, as they sit and await their check-in call by the receptionist. Sometime around 7:30 each morning, a dedicated Christian man from the local church comes and gives a brief devotional, sings a song or two with the waiting patients, and ends with a prayer to bless them and demonstrate why the clinic exists. At 8:00 a.m. the receptionists and nurses arrive to begin the check-in and screening process, so that when the doctors arrive at 9:00 a.m., the patients are ready to be seen. The pharmacy, radiology and laboratory personnel take their places and wait for their role in the patient care. Some days, the dentist, the optometrist, the prosthetist or a surgeon add their specialty services. The day continues on and the services needed and provided vary greatly from treating a parasitic infection, a sickle cell crisis, malnutrition, an abscessed tooth, making a prosthetic leg or treating injuries from a motorcycle accident the night before. The clinic winds down mid-afternoon as several of the staff need to travel many miles to return home before the day begins again. Our goal is to become a 24/7 hospital, but in the meantime, every day, every week that passes, we seek to serve those in need in Christ's name!
