Prior to the earthquake of 2010, the plans for the prosthetic laboratory were already in the works, with Florida prosthetist, David Huse, at the helm. Through generous donations from the Church of God and the Knupp Family (both from Anderson, Indiana), the prosthetic laboratory was completed. Currently, the hospital employs a Haitian prosthetist and his assistant a minimum of three days every month. The bulk of their work involves fabricating prosthetic legs and leg braces for the mobility challenged.
