At the inception of emergency care for medical teams from MHM, an obvious fracture was splinted in the best possible fashion, using ingenuity, determination and a lot of "guesswork" as to how the fracture could be approximated. Eventually an old bedside portable unit was donated and shipped, providing the beginnings of our radiology department. As the needs continued to grow, our radiology area was lead-lined, a second better portable unit was purchased and flat film digital radiology was begun at our hospital in 2015. Currently the hospital employs two radiology technicians, with a third on call.

## future plans

With the help of Fountains of Hope, an Indiana-based non-profit, and their board member, Dr. Tim Dicke, the hospital is on the precipice of 3-D imaging using a C-arm. We are excited for this possibility, and hope to further expand our ability to provide better 3-D imaging via a CT scanner in the future.
