A STEP OF FAITH

For many months, the community surrounding our healthcare facility in St. Ard has been strongly advocating for us to open an emergency care facility to function around the clock. The only other local emergency room (ER) facility has significant funding problems and often cannot provide the level of care needed. We have the beds, some monitors, and many of the supplies needed to open for after-hours care. We do not, however, have the finances needed to provide staffing, a continuous supply of supplies, nor an updated energy source to provide after-hours light and electricity. With the help of our visiting friends from Florida Station Church of God, we recently cleaned and prepared the area for the emergency department, complete with placing the beds at their stations. Moses built the ark before the rain began in anticipation of what God would do. In the same way, we are trusting that He will provide what we need to open the ER. I recently read that "Gratitude is thanking God after He does it. Faith is thanking God before He does it." **So, God, thank you in advance!**

NEW BEGINNINGS

The dental and eye clinic at our facility was recently moved to the second floor of the building as mandated by the Haitian government. This results in all general health care being provided on the first floor of the facility, with specialty services (eye, dental, prosthetics) located on the second floor. The recent move vacated the area needed for the ER facility (see above article) and created a wonderful new space for our specialty services. While still in the organizational phase, the new space for specialty services is being used and is continuously being developed. What a blessing! We have special gratitude for Drs. Jeff Steele and Lee Mitchell who sacrificed long hours to help with the development of the dental area; our friends at Rhonda Eye Alliance who designed and will supervise the optical portion and, once again, our friends at Florida Station Church of God who provided hours of tireless labor. **God is so good!**

SPECIAL PRAYER REQUESTS

- An old friend in Haiti, Wiznel Beauvoir, needs prayer for his 18 year-old son, Anderson, who has been unconscious for a few weeks following an accident involving a drunk driver. We periodically bring supplies from the hospital to the nurse who is caring for him in his home in the village, which has no electricity or running water, but an abundance of church people and family helping, praying and supporting the family.
