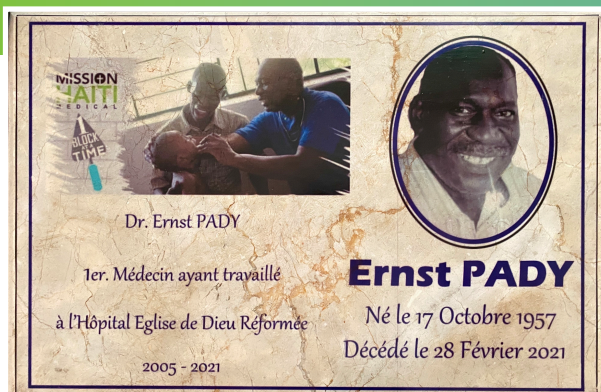

A Time to Mourn

The tragic death on the last day of February this year of the founding doctor at Hôpital L'Eglise de Dieu Réformée brought the staff together to mourn and celebrate his life of generosity.

Dr. Ernst Pady was celebrated at the hospital with a memorial service on March 12. Following the service, a memorial plaque was presented and will be permanently placed where he served: the pediatric area. Many of you have thoughtfully presented gifts in his memory, which will be used to not only place the plaque but to purchase some new pediatric equipment and to revamp the pediatric area. We have been



blessed by his sacrificial giving to the lives of children all over Haiti, and we have been humbled by your gifts. A Time of Turmoil

Over the last couple of years, Haiti has experienced historic levels of civil unrest and extreme economic hardship. A few months ago, the unrest manifested itself in even more extreme ways, as kidnappings, roadblocks, and civil disturbance increased dramatically. The doctors at Hôpital L'Eglise de Dieu Réformée often have great difficulty navigating the roads, and some weeks there is only a fraction of the usual doctor hours at the facility. The entire country is suffering in so many ways, as normal Haitian life grinds to a halt on many days. In spite of this, the emergency room and the outpatient clinic at Hôpital L'Eglise de Dieu Réformée continue to function with whomever can make it to work, with whatever medicines we can find, and with the hope that Christ will bless the work of our hands beyond what we can humanly accomplish. A huge thank you to the entire staff of Hôpital L'Eglise de Dieu Réformée, who are our champion frontline providers! We continue to pray for all of them, and the entire country of Haiti. We ask you to join us!
