#### An Important Hidden Part Of Unprecedented Times, The Hospital

In the late 1990s, a 9' x 14' hole was dug near the hospital, lined with cement blocks, and large drainage pipes were directed to it. The hole was then covered with a metal-reinforced concrete lid and a drain field was created going away from it. This septic system has functioned, well, until (you guessed it!) late in 2020. While the costs of replacing the septic system were a difficult expense to shoulder especially during a pandemic and an economic downturn, God provided a way! With the financial help of our friends at Kinderhilfswerk/AktionDeutschlandHilft, and weeks of physical labor from our Haitian friends near the hospital, a new and improved septic system was provided. A septic system is something you don't appreciate or even talk about until it is not available. Even in things unseen or seemingly forgotten, God takes care of the details!
