Double Blessing

At her home in a small village, a mom delivered twins of approximately 32-34 weeks' gestation. The young ones were not able to nurse normally and exhibited some signs and symptoms that necessitated their transfer to a facility that might be better equipped for premature births. Often even the best facilities in Haiti are unable to obtain the supplies and equipment they need for situations such as this, and parents are many times unable to travel to a hospital far away on uncertain roads. These particular parents agreed to go to another facility, and also promised that if the new facility was unable to accomplish what was needed, they would return to our hospital. This is not an abnormal situation for us or any rural hospital in Haiti. Roads are dangerous. Supplies are limited and funds for even the transportation are often inadequate. We pray for parents who make these tough decisions. We pray for the facilities that battle daily to do their best with what is available. And, we especially pray for the kids who find themselves caught in the middle of a struggle for life.
