Just Keep Moving Forward

"If you can't fly, then run. If you can't run, then walk. If you can't walk, then crawl. But whatever you do, you have to keep moving forward." Martin Luther King, Jr.

When the social and political odds seem to be stacked against the success of the hospital, the administrative team in Saintard creatively keeps the facility moving forward in any way that is feasible. The road between the hospital and Port au Prince, the source of supplies and the home of many of the employees, has not been passable since September 11.



Gangs have made it their business to control the flow of provisions and fuel to all communities, as they make a stand for change in the governmental structure of Haiti. The fallout of this approach is an untenable way of life for the millions of Haitians who are caught in the middle. To provide some continuity of medical care for the Saintard community, the local administrative team at the hospital identified and recruited some local physicians and nurses to fill in for the members of the hospital staff who are unable to navigate the roads. The emergency department continues to be staffed and care has been available 24/7 since the beginning of this extreme time of crisis in Haiti. As potable water and sufficient food become more and more scarce, waterborne illnesses and malnutrition plague the community. The medical staff is forced to be more creative in their approach to care due to the limited resources, but we are thankful that Hôpital L'Eglise de Dieu Réformée continues to function: to move forward, probably not at the speed of flying, running, or even walking, but as long as we can crawl, with the help of God, we will keep moving forward together! May God hear our prayers!

Re-equipping the Hospital

As the hospital staff has not been able to replenish stock due to the road being blocked for many weeks, the shelves at Hôpital L'Eglise de Dieu Réformée have become increasingly empty. The extra bandages, back-up supplies of medicine, boxes of syringes, IV tubing, needles - everything - will need to be restocked once this season of crisis is behind us. For that reason, we are focusing on collecting funds to re-equip the hospital when the procuring of supplies becomes possible again.



Each November, in conjunction with Giving Tuesday, we have a year-end campaign to help the hospital in Saintard, and this year, that campaign becomes even more vitally important as we see unprecedented instability in Haiti.

Again this year, we have been blessed by anonymous individuals who have donated funds available to match *up to \$17,500 - dollar for dollar* - to make every year-end donation go twice the distance! We continue to pray for peace. We continue to pray for change. We continue to pray to be prepared to re-stock the shelves when the time arrives.
